

Ask the children to add the new images to their own Theme Pages, and you can do the same in the classroom. Feel free to vary the approach. Every pupil makes Theme Pages based on their own logic and ideas. The idea is to visualise semantic groups which help the pupils to remember the words.

La canción: “Quisiera ser tan alta”

Prezi contains three versions of the song. Doing the actions while they are singing the song makes it more fun for the pupils and also helps them to remember the words. You can make up your own actions together with the children or use the ones that Anne has thought up.

At the end of the song, the boy finds a silver statuette of the Virgin Mary and a gold statuette of Jesus. If you prefer, you can use the version which ends with a pause, and the pupils can decide what kind of treasure they would like to discover (version 2).

There is also a sheet-music version of the song (version 3) so that you can practise the song together with the pupils. Furthermore, you can work with them to think up new ways to help them learn the song off by heart (jumping, dancing, singing to each other, singing in a round, playing musical instruments as well, etc.).

Song lyrics:
